To look at loan and grant options for future pipeline work and to possibly connect to San Jose water in the future, Frank moved to have Bud attend the August 30th Funding Fair in San Dieog, presented by the California Funding Coordinating Committee (CFCC), and inquire if Andi Henke would also be able to attend, as she is well-versed in grant proposals. Bruce seconded. Passed unanimously.

Rebecca and Kirk will work on getting road bids to have work done in September.

Kenji: work with Marco, Joe Thorsen, Vu and Quinto to assess road needs, estimate costs, walk through with contractors, review bids and options.

5-year Budget and Capital Improvement Plan: 2017 – 2022

Kenji and Bud are working on developing a budget and capital improvement plan.

Road Maintenance

Kenji, Kirk, Marco Casillas and Bud walked the canyon, and estimated that \$70,000 is needed for immediate repairs. Kirk walked the canyon with a representative from Corey, looking at options including patching and an overlay. Kirk will seek an additional bid to enable the board to vote at the Sept. 13th meeting and start repairs as soon as possible.

Fire Lanes - striping: Is being deferred until after paving.

Road Safety - Speed Bumps: Cost would be \$1200 each for 2 speed bumps.

Members Meeting: Saturday, Sept. 23 - Board candidates,

Discussed elections, mail proxies / voting procedures, 2-person vote validation

Rebecca was authorized to have a vinyl sign made to announce the meeting and be used annually.

Kenji moved and Bruce seconded to adjourn to September 13th at 7:00 pm at the filter site. Passed unanimously.
